

# Central Square Traffic Circulation Study Public Information Meeting

The objectives of this meeting will be to explain project goals, existing conditions, preliminary alternatives and solicit public input for further consideration.



## study area

The traffic circulation study area encompasses the US Route 11 / NYS 49 intersection, and the adjacent intersections with CR12 (Caughdenoy Rd.) and CR12 (Mallory Rd.)

## study goals

- Study roadway accessibility, mobility and safety.
- Study connectivity between local streets.
- Study alternative routes around the Village.

## study purpose

A comprehensive transportation circulation study was commissioned by the Village of Central Square, under a grant obtained through the NYSDOT, to explore and analyze solutions for traffic issues in the Village. Traffic volumes have been increasing over the years, especially with commercial development along the NYS 49 corridor and continued residential development in the surrounding Town of Hastings and Central Square School District. This problem is widely recognized as a major impediment to development and revitalization of the Village, as well as an impediment to pedestrian circulation and safety. The existing conditions and preliminary traffic analysis completed thus far is just a starting point. The NYSDOT currently has an intersection improvement project programmed on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and will be completing a more detailed analysis of improvement alternatives, design, and finally, construction of the project. During that process additional public outreach will be conducted.
